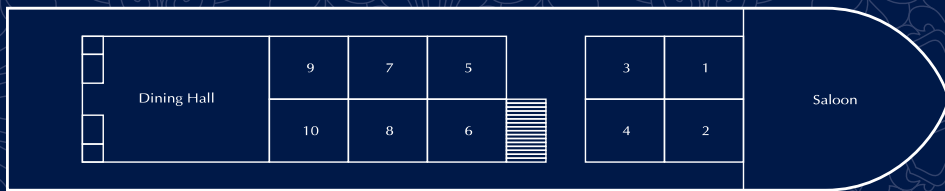




ELEVATION

ON BOARD

There are altogether 16 teak-walled deluxe cabins with proper beds and hot and cold showers. There is one main deck with cabins, an upper deck with cabins and a dining room at the stern and a salon at the prow.

The topmost 20ft long sundeck is fitted with comfortable rattan chairs, giving a pleasant old-world ambience as guests view the sunset, river traffic and pretty villages on the banks. The cozy bar is a great place to hang out with friends late into the night, and the elegant dining room is where guests will enjoy lavish meals of great dishes such as roasted pork with apple marmalade sauce, beef escalope with red wine sauce, sautéed seafood with lime cream sauce and butterfish prepared in a number of ways. Vegetarian meals can be prepared when informed in advance.

TECHNICAL SPECS

Her hull is of steel, and she measures 150ft (47.72 m) from prow to stern. Her beam is 34 ft (11.5m) and the light draft is 2.6ft (0.8m)

The engine runs with diesel, 2x300hp MWM Model TBD -234 V6.

Propulsion is Schotell Outboard Model SRP 100. 110. Maximum upriver speed is 6 nautical mph and downriver speed is 11 nautical mph. The generators are 2x95 kva Denyo Gensets.

For communications, there is a GSM phone, internal phone system and tannoy for navigation. The vessel is outfitted with navigation lights, ship horn and search light and for safety precautions, there are emergency lights, emergency generator, life jackets for all on board and rigid floatation devices.

SAFETY

For fire protection there are 21 smoke detectors, 4 heat detectors, 8 manual alarm stations, a USA-made electronic control panel Silent Knight, 20 fire extinguishers, 8 fire hose cabinets and fire pump.

For health safety, there is a desedimentation and full water treatment system plus the Reverse Osmosis system for the kitchen. A treatment plant is used for sewage.

GOLDEN MYANMAR

BETWEEN PROME & BEYOND MANDALAY
10 nights cruise on original PANDAW (1947)

UPSTREAM

DAY 1: RANGOON/YANGON – PROME/PYAY
Drive to Prome by coach and board Pandaw1947. Visit Thayekhittaya (also known as Sri Ksetra, the “Fabulous city” in Pali language), an ancient Pyu city that ruled in this area between the 5th and the 9th century AD.

DAY 2: THAYETMYO – MINHLA
Thayetmyo: the oldest golf course of Myanmar, the market and the old colonial houses.

DAY 3: MINHLA – MAGWE
Visit Minhla and Gwechaung, the two forts built by two Italian Military Engineers for the Burmese King in order to keep the British at bay at the time of the 2nd Anglo-Burmese War. In the afternoon arrive Magwe. Visit the 1929 built pagoda of gold solid bricks set on a hilltop with a beautiful view of the river.

DAY 4: MAGWE – SALAY
Visit the Magwe picturesque market by trishaw. Sail all day upstream.

DAY 5: SALAY – TAN KYI

Visit Salay, a village founded in the 13th century with Bagan-era shrines, beautiful 19th century teak monasteries and preserved British colonial buildings. Continue upriver to the village of Tan Kyi. Reach the mountaintop by WW2 jeep where stands one of the four stupa that marked the original edges of the city and enjoy a marvelous sunset over Bagan plain.

DAY 6: BAGAN

We visit a selection of the 2,000 listed pagodas and temples and lacquerware shops in Bagan.

DAY 7: BAGAN – YANDABO

We cruise upstream all day with stop at Shwe Pyi Thar village for a walk. In the early evening we arrive at Yandabo, a picturesque village that specializes in Pot-Making. Dinner followed by a Puppet Show performance in the village or sundeck.

DAY 8: YANDABO – AVA

We continue upstream to the ancient city of Ava, capital of the Burmese Kingdom from 1364 to 1841.

DAY 9: AVA – MANDALAY AMARAPURA – KYAUK MYAUNG

We explore Ava by horse-cart. We travel by sampan and coach to Amarapura, the penultimate Burmese Royal Capital (1783) to visit U-Bein Bridge followed by central Mandalay visiting Mahamuni Pagoda, a Gold leaf making workshop. Moor overnight nearby a river village North of Mandalay.

DAY 10: KYAUK MYAUNG – MINGUN – SAGAING

Visit the spectacular potteries-making village of Kyauk Myaung, and see the manufacture stages of the famous 50 Gallons (200 Litres) pots. Cruise downstream to Mingun where we visited the unfinished pagoda, the largest working bell in the world and the “home for the aged”. Dance and Theatre performance on the Sundeck.

DAY 11: SAGAING (DISEMBARK)

Disembark at Sagaing.

Downstream program is in reverse.

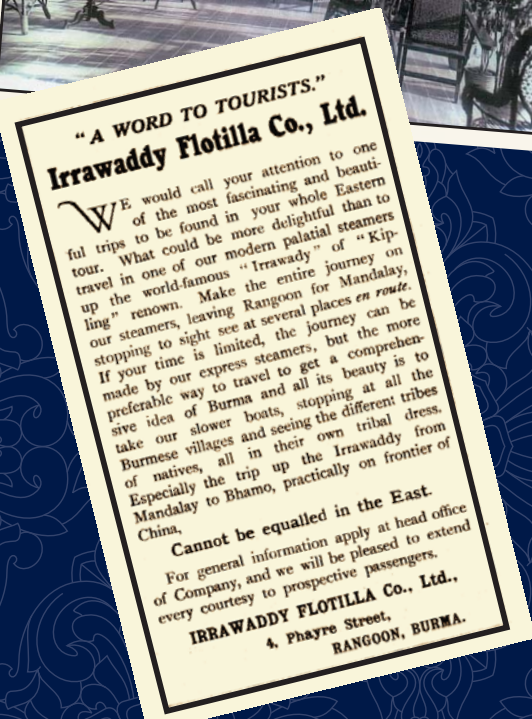
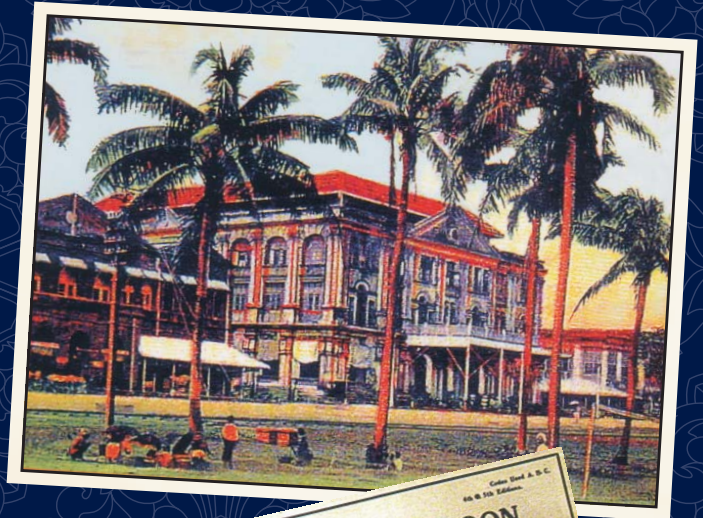

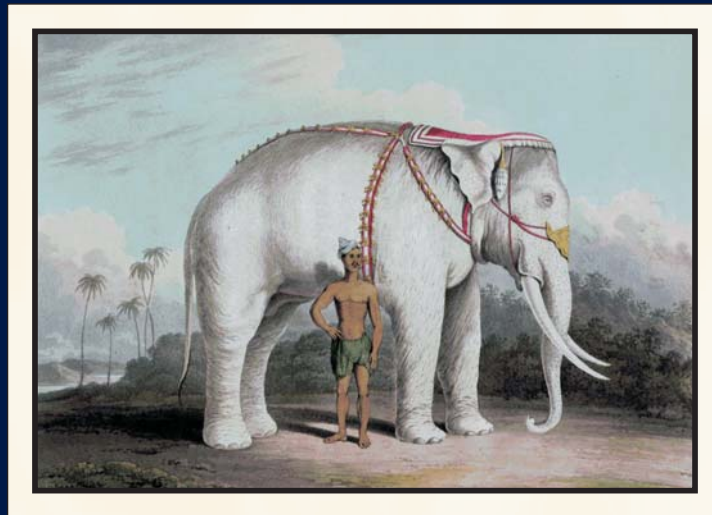
